

# Medicaid Quality Frameworks National Advisory Board

UnitedHealthcare formed an independent National Advisory Board in 2013 to provide guidance in serving members with complex needs. In 2015, the board was asked to develop quality measurement frameworks for Medicaid members in need of long-term services and supports (LTSS) and who have intellectual disabilities and/or developmental disabilities (ID/DD).
